

Much has been accomplished in the past eight months, thanks to the active involvement of our schools, principals, teachers, and volunteers. Together, we continue to ensure that community language education in NSW remains strong, sustainable, and safe.

Child Safety - Our Highest Priority

The safety and wellbeing of children remains at the core of everything we do. All schools must:

• Ensure **Child Safety Policies** are up to date, accessible, and actively followed.

<u>Student Safety & Staff Welfare Policies & Procedures Manual</u> 2024. provided by our national body, Community Languages Australia.

• Provide regular training for staff and volunteers.

<u>Self-Assessment Tool for Community Language Schools</u>, provided by our national body, Community Languages Australia.

"These are not simply recommendations — they are essential obligations to protect our children and the future of our schools."

"All schools must maintain Public Liability Insurance."



For the period **31 May 2025 to 31 May 2026**, Public Liability Insurance has been provided for our member schools. This policy has been reviewed and expanded, and now includes:

- Public Liability
- Products Liability
- Professional Indemnity (newly added in 2025)
- Voluntary Workers Accident Cover

This more comprehensive policy also **indemnifies the NSW Department of Education**, ensuring compliance and strengthening protection for our sector.

Master Policy for Association Liability Insurance — a new layer of protection for your school's management.

Association Liability Insurance (1 May 2025 – 1 May 2026)

In response to concerns raised by member schools about protecting school management and committee members from potential risks such as:

- Inadequate or incompetent supervision
- Ineffective administration
- Inaccurate or misleading reporting or disclosure of the organisation's accounts
- Misuse of assets
- Discrimination and/or harassment
- · Wrongful dismissal or termination
- Employee theft

the Federation has successfully negotiated a Master Policy for Association Liability Insurance.

This important new layer of protection ensures that management are personally insured in the event of litigation, and committee members are supported in carrying out their responsibilities, while providing greater peace of mind for schools and associations.
